Through grassroots 218 NGO partners, CRY ensures that Primary Health Centres (PHCs) are functional, pre/post natal care services are available and immunisation camps are organised.

CRY and its alliance partners lobby for policy level changes for quality, free and equal education. Children are encouraged to attend bridge classes or non-formal educational centres after which they are admitted to government schools that function properly.

1,139 villages were child labour free

By mobilising communities to ask for minimum wages and avail government schemes, we ensure that parents do not have to send children to work.
