Save The Children India is a non-profit organization established by Mrs. Vipula Kadri in 1988 to support and empower underprivileged women and children. Till date, Save The Children India has reached out to over 200,000 beneficiaries in the areas of education, health, prevention of human trafficking, and vocational training.

A BRIEF INTRODUCTION TO OUR PROJECTS -

- **Special Care Centre** - A school for special children situated at Bandra-Kurla complex which takes care of the academic, vocational and nutritious needs of more than 250 Hearing Impaired and Mentally Challenged children from the slums of northern Mumbai.
- **Balwadi** - Recognizing the importance of engaging pre-school slum children in meaningful activities, around 150 Balwadis are running in BMC schools and community centres. These children are being convincingly prepared for entry level into good schools in their locality.
- **Study Centre** - 112 Comprehensive Study Centers running across 60 locations for remedial teaching programs facilitating education for children who are academically far behind than class level.
- **Dhvani** - Early Intervention Centre for children with speech and hearing impairments through Auditory Verbal Therapy as well as Cochlear Implant Surgery.
- **W.I.S.E (Women's Institute for Social Education)**- This project looks after vocational and livelihood training to adolescent girls with the aim of making them self sufficient and economically independent. There are 34 such centers running in northern Mumbai.
- **Save Our Sisters** - A movement engineered towards prevention of human trafficking right from the source area to the destiny is handled holistically through rehabilitation, advocacy and awareness program.
- **P.R.I.D.E India (Planning Rural-Urban Integrated Development through Education)**- This rural arm of Save The Children India has intervention in Mahad, Raigad district and Sastur, Osmanabad.
At Mahad, 40 villages have been impacted through the livelihood, education and health programs.
At Sastur, a 40 bed hospital came up in the post Latur earthquake, to provide succor to the quake hit villages around Osmanabad district. A Community Care Centre supported by NACO looks after inflicted patient.
- **Prevention of Malnutrition in Melghat district:** Looking at the terrifying report coming about children dying due to Malnutrition we have intervened in 10 worst affected villages with comprehensive water harvesting, and prevention of malnourishment program.
- **Delhi Chapter:** It replicates Mumbai's initiatives but on a smaller scale. The interventions are all in the very sensitive Sarai Kale Khan area in Nizamuddin. (East) which is home for migrants from UP and Bihar.
