What students take away?




First Hand experience

How does it work?

The school receives a complete Clap Kit™that has everything needed to curate a fabulous Clap Talk™. Teachers create their date and Clap time-slots. Travellers add their available dates. Through matching of dates, teachers can then browse through profiles and invite a traveller.

The aim of a pre-primary Clap Talk is to make an emotional connection with the children. The focus of the Clap Curriculum© at this stage is more on unity than diversity, so that children are able to view people from around the world with all their differences - their accent, colour of their skin and eyes - as their own, their friends. 












A Child's Clap Timeline from age four to fifteen.
