How is it assessed?

It will be assessed by your tutor or assessor using a range of methods. This could include direct observation in the workplace, a portfolio of evidence, written assignments or a task set by us.

What are the entry requirements?

You should be at least 18 years old and have passed the class 12th exam.

When will this qualification be available?

This qualification will be open for registrations from 15th March 2016.
